## ONLINE MODULES with American Public University System

To complete the P.Log. completely online through our Online Process Management Program, three of the seven modules required will be delivered by our partner, American Public University System (APU).

### Logistics Institute Modules = Equivalent APU Modules:

Supply Chain Strategies	=	International Logistics Management (TLMT 342) <b>OR</b> Global Logistics Management (TLMT 611)
Leadership Strategies	=	Leadership & Motivation (MGMT 312) <b>OR</b> Leadership (MGMT 605)
Professional Ethics	=	Management Ethics (MGMT 314) <b>OR</b> Ethics & Leadership (MGMT 618)

One credit per course will be granted towards the P.Log. designation upon receipt of an official transcript from American Public University System showing your successful completion. You will register with APUS directly and pay course fees directly to APUS.

<b>Registration Deadline</b>	Sunday prior to the first Monday of each month
<b>Application and Registration</b>	Completed online through APUS' website
<b>Duration</b>	8 weeks in length each

## APU Enrollment Path for Logistics Institute

To determine which APUS courses are correct for you, please follow this matrix.

If you have a BA degree, please enroll for the **RED** courses.

If you do not have a BA, please enroll for the **BLUE** courses.

Equal credit toward the P.Log. designation is awarded regardless of the pathway you take.

In order to apply credits towards a Masters degree with APUS, the **RED** courses are required. However, only candidates who hold a BA degree are able to take these graduate level courses.
